



RINGMER WI NEWS

In May, we welcomed Louise Peskett to talk to us about Sussex women who made their names through cooking. Eliza Acton wrote the first illustrated cookbook in 1845, aimed at the domestic reader. It contained recipes for Christmas (not plum!) pudding, Mulligatawny soup and chutney. She was somewhat eclipsed by Isabella Beaton, who actually plagiarised many of Eliza's recipes. Elizabeth David was strongly influenced by the Mediterranean diet. Her books included French and Italian recipes and summer cooking - rather different from what she described as cheerless, tasteless food of post-war Britain! Marguerite Patten was one of the earliest celebrity chefs who published 170 cookbooks. She became known during the war when she shared recipes that worked with war rationing. Fanny Cradock's food was inventive and imaginative, but her recipe for baked hedgehog or plates decorated with pigeon wings are not quite to modern tastes! She is remembered for her flamboyant dress and her hen-pecking of husband Johnny! Margaret Powell, wrote extensively about her life 'below stairs', which inspired the TV dramas *Upstairs Downstairs* and *Downton Abbey*.

Our next meeting will be on Tuesday 3 June when Stuart Corner will provide a fascinating insight into the life for the honey bee as well as explaining where honey, bees wax and Royal Jelly come from and why bees swarm.



The Lewes District Local Plan: No change from last month's note: the current phase of consultation is over – but there's

more to come. RAGE will do its best to keep you informed on the next stage.

Catesby Estates/Howells Bank Farm: Members of the Action Group of RAGE have been doing a sterling job analysing the reams of documentation submitted by Catesby: there's a lot of bulk but not much reality. Did you realise that in order to meet the timings of your walk to the shops in Ringmer you have to maintain an overall walking pace of 3mph along footpaths up to two metres wide? These don't exist, but we all know places on Broyle Lane where pedestrians cannot pass if there's a pushchair involved – the only passage is via the road. More next time... There's still time to object – many have done so, more objections add weight to the protest. Remember who ultimately owns Catesby – we say NOT WELLCOME HERE!

RAGE will keep you advised as soon as more is known about Turnpike Farm, **JOIN RAGE:** Head to ringmergreenfields.org and make sure you have your own DON'T URBANISE RINGMER placard on display.

Recycling garden waste into compost is easy and environmentally friendly. Home made compost improves the soil structure, aeration, and biodiversity. In a small garden try starting with a bin or in a larger garden in an enclosed heap built from wooden pallets or recycled planks. Choose a sheltered and accessible spot in partial shade. Compost is built up of layers of green and brown materials. Green includes grass clippings, weeds, old fruit and vegetable and kitchen peelings. Brown is dry woody waste such as hedge clippings, dead grasses, and straw, and torn up shredded paper and cardboard. Aim roughly for 25-50% soft green and 50-75% brown, avoiding too many grass cuttings which can become slimy. Ideally the compost should be turned regularly to add air and watered in summer if it starts to dry out. Garden compost can take six months to two years to mature and is ready when it becomes dark brown and crumbly. Then it makes a wonderful mulch and soil improver to break up heavy clay soil.

NEWS FROM THE BEVERN TRUST

The hydrotherapy pool at Bevern View has long been one of the most important spaces for residents. For people who are profoundly disabled the chance to be



supported in water — free to move, stretch, and simply be — is nothing short of transformative. After 14 years of use, the pool recently needed urgent re-tiling, and thanks to a huge effort, we were able to get the funds and complete this.

But as is often the way with essential facilities, one fix revealed others: a failing chemical dosing machine and a hidden underfloor leak have caused fresh challenges, meaning more time out of the pool and even more funds needed.

PARISH COUNCIL REPORT

At the Annual Statutory meeting on 6 May, Cllr. Gordon Sims was re-elected chair and Cllr. Sarah Phillips was re-elected vice-chair for the ensuing year. As we start a new Parish Council year, it's an opportunity to reflect on achievements in the past 12 months. Our social media presence was greatly improved. The skate park and new play park project in Fingerpost Field was successfully completed. Plans to rejuvenate the shopping precinct have been formulated and the work will soon be

going out to tender. Work to re-open the swimming pool is near completion and the pool is due to open in June. We submitted our views on the Lewes Local Plan document and will respond once more when the final draft is out for consultation in the summer. WILDFLOWER RINGMER

Well done everyone who participated in No Mow May. By allowing grass and wildflowers to grow your garden will have provided essential nectar and pollen for early-season pollinators such as bees and butterflies. Your less manicured lawn will have supported a greater variety of wildlife. You may have noticed more birds pecking around in the longer grass? Please don't snatch this habitat and food away by close mowing your lawn too soon,

No Mow May is just the beginning. To help pollinators and other wildlife continue to follow Let It Bloom June and Mow-saic months all the way through the summer. They're all part of the growing No Mow Movement. The term Mow-Saic means leaving some longer areas of grassland throughout the



summer and trimming others to a height of one to two inches – rather like a Mohawk haircut. This allows plants such as daisies, self heal an bird's foot trefoil to flower in the shorter grass. You may also have seen that this year most areas of the Village Green [above] are being cut with raised blades to maintain a slightly longer sward. As a result, daisies are flowering and we hope other low flowering flowers will join them. This is a deliberate change by Ringmer Parish Council to benefit pollinators while maintaining the amenity value of the Green for residents. To our eyes, it is much more attractive and should avoid the bare soil issue of previous summers. Why not do similar on your lawn?




