

LETTER FROM ST MARY'S



Dear Friends

As I was wandering the internet I came across the following story which says what I wanted to talk about this month: "A mother, wishing to encourage her son's progress at the piano, bought tickets to a performance by the great Polish pianist Ignace Paderewski. When the evening arrived, they found their seats near the front of the concert hall and eyed the majestic Steinway waiting on the stage. Soon the mother found a friend to talk to, and the boy slipped away.

"At eight o'clock, the lights in the auditorium began to dim, the spotlights came on, and only then did they notice the boy - up on the piano bench, innocently picking out *Twinkle*, *Twinkle Little Star*. His mother gasped in shock and embarrassment but, before she could retrieve her son, the master himself appeared on the stage and quickly moved to the keyboard. He whispered gently to the boy: 'Don't quit. Keep playing'. Leaning over, Paderewski reached down with his left hand and began filling in the bass part. Soon his right arm reached around the other side and improvised a delightful obligato. Together, the old master and the young novice held the crowd mesmerized with their blended and beautiful music."

I'm sorry to say that, after research, I found the above to be folklore but the truth within the story still holds up I believe.

We often think that our contribution is too small, too insignificant in the scale of the world we live in. We feel like the small boy picking out an meaningless tune on a Steinway grand piano – but if our small part was not there, not part of the whole piece then the whole would not be complete. So I encourage you to do the small thing: Don't quit. Keep playing.





PARISH OWNED LAND

The green space around the village pump will be named 'Pump Green' and will be registered as a 'Village Green'. Council advised that access to a proposed new cemetery could not be through the Almond Field, as restrictive covenants associated with the land transfer prohibit such use. Work on the Jubilee Gardens beds continues, concentrating on the final bed. Volunteers are always welcome to help with routine gardening such as keeping on top of the bindweed!

IMPROVING THE NATURAL ENVIRONMENT IN RINGMER

Work has continued throughout the summer on the Almond Field, maintaining the paths and clearing unwanted bramble and blackthorn.
