

Come and celebrate with us the goodness of God in creation, in our community, and in our daily lives. May this Harvest be a reminder that every good gift comes from above, and that when we share freely, we reveal something of God's kingdom here among us.

#### RINGMER WI NEWS

On Tuesday 2 September, we welcomed Robin Kyte who told the story of the grounding of the Dutch East India Company (VOC) ship, The Amsterdam, at Bulverhythe in 1749. After two failed attempts, the ship finally set sail on its maiden voyage in bad weather on January 3rd 1749. On 20 January, the ship lost its rudder. The crew, many of

whom were suffering from plague (55 died), mutinied. The captain decided to ground the ship off Pevensey Bay, but overshot and ended up in the soft mud off Bulverhythe, where the major part of the hull still rests today. It remains the best-preserved VOC ship ever found and much of the valuable cargo still remains, inaccessible, in the hold. Our next meeting is on Tuesday 7 October at 7.30pm, when Bonnie Tse will tell us about how the lives of people with physical disabilities are transformed by partnering them with highly trained assistance dogs. Visitors are welcome to attend two meetings a year, after which we hope you will join!



#### **ECO TIP - WATER BUTTS**

Drought conditions are becoming very common and so it makes sense to install a water butt to collect rain water for watering the garden.

It is better for plants than tap water because it is softer and free of chemicals and is more convenient compared with carrying cans from the house during hose pipe bans. The butt can be placed on level ground near any rain water downpipe from the house or garage and ideally in the shade to minimise bacteria growth. It needs to be on a stand or bricks to fit a watering can under the tap and then connected with the diverter kit provided. To avoid smells the butt should be cleaned annually and the water used frequently to prevent the build-up of debris. Grey water from washing up and clothes washing can also be used in the garden, but avoid water containing bleach, disinfectant dishwater salt or cleaning products.

#### RINGMER HISTORY GROUP

#### HISTORIC RINGMER BUILDINGS

The Parish Council is now undertaking a revision of the Ringmer Neighbourhood Plan. For the original version, a decade ago, the Ringmer History Group contributed a list of 20 historic local buildings that qualified to be 'locally listed'.

This has proven to be a successful policy, with planners, developers and even planning inspectors hearing Ringmer appeals accepting the designation without demur.

During October the History Group will be considering whether there are additional historic buildings that should be added to this list in the new Neighbourhood Plan. We have come up with another 20 candidates, published in the September Ringmer History Newsletter (available to non-members in the Ringmer Community Library).

At our meeting in Ringmer Village Hall at 7.30 pm on Friday 24 October we shall be discussing which, if any, of these deserve inclusion in the new 'local list'. Everyone is welcome to attend. The picture shows Moor House on Moor Lane, an example of the kind of historical building that is under discussion. Built in the 1870s on the site of a much smaller house by a wealthy young widow who moved from Lewes High Street to this then isolation location. She died only a few years later and it was used as a tenanted farmhouse.


