Sarah's Story (The Matriarchs and Patriarchs)

Genesis 18, 1-15

For Reflection:

How hard might it have been for Sarah to hear of Abraham's conversations with God but not to encounter god herself until the Lord appeared at the Oaks of Mamre? Abraham is praised for his faith, but what might this have felt like for Sarah?

Abraham and Sarah had to wait a very long time for God's promises to be fulfilled, without knowing they ever would be. Waiting is never easy. What have you learned about waiting in your life?

Think about laughter. What different kinds of laughter are there? Could laughter be important for us spiritually?

Luke 1.26-37

Matthew 1.18-25

For Reflection:

How much do you think Mary and Joseph understood about Jesus and who he would be?

What inspires you most about the character of Mary?

What do you thinks are some of the key 'projections' we make onto Mary?
