





There was, surprisingly, nothing material concerning RAGE at the October, Howells Bank Farm is the

oldest of three large applications seeking to add another 360 houses to the 500 permissions gained but not yet implemented and the next possible date is 3 December in Newhaven, Please anticipate that and be ready for the call to arms - make diary entries, negotiate lift shares, anything to get as many as possible to attend!

The other matter of concern is the Lewes Local Plan – currently under preparation behind closed doors. 
